You might be eligible for funding to improve the energy efficiency of your home if your household earns less than £30,000 and your home has an energy performance rating of D or lower.

Get help with...

- ◆ **Draught proofing windows and doors:** double or triple glazing, secondary glazing, upgrading to energy efficient doors
- ◆ **Heating controls:** appliance thermostats, hot water tank thermostats, hot water tank insulation, smart heating controls, zone controls, delayed start thermostat, thermostatic radiator valves
- ◆ **Insulation:** solid wall, cavity wall, under-floor, loft, flat roof, room in roof
- ◆ **Low carbon heat:** air source heat pump, solar thermal
